## Franklin High School National Honor Society Procedures for Membership

Membership in the National Honor Society is by invitation of the school faculty. Sophomores, juniors, and seniors who have maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.30 are eligible for admission. If interested in membership, they are required to complete and submit data sheets attesting to their involvement in school and community activities and solicit teacher, advisor, or coach input.

#### Part 1: Service

To qualify in the service category, students must attain points that are distributed in a minimum of six service categories listed below. At each grade level, the requisite number of points is as follows:

Grade 10: 2 Points from 2 categories (below); 1 must be in FHS setting
Grade 11: 3 Points from 3 categories (below); 2 must be in FHS setting
Grade 12: 5 Points from 3 categories (below); 2 must be in FHS setting

Please be aware that membership in a club or religious group does not in itself constitute service. If you perform a service activity with the club or religious group, the service hours are for the activity only, not for general meetings or trips. Activities conducted for self-improvement, monetary payment, or school credit (i.e. Journalism, Music Classes) will not be awarded service points. Students earn points for hours of service performed as stated:

- ½ service point for short-term activities (5-10 hours)
- 1 service point for long-term activities (10 or more hours)

Remember that your service points must be distributed based on the requirements above for your grade level.

- Clubs/Class Organizations/Student Government
- Drama/Music/Art (involvement **beyond** the classroom)
- Publications (involvement **beyond** the classroom)
- Service Within the Community (charities, activities assisting others)
- Service Within the School (teacher aides, peer tutoring, office aides)
- Sports (school and community)

#### Part 2: Leadership

Leadership is defined as the outstanding demonstration of resourcefulness, initiative, reliability, and dependability both in the classroom and within the school and the community. Students must influence others in a positive manner. In order to qualify in this category, it is not essential that you hold an elective office. Those who have not been elected to leadership positions must be identified as leaders by at least four Franklin High School teachers. It is also possible to fulfill the leadership requirement by holding two elected positions or holding one elected position and two Franklin High School teacher recommendations. Examples of leadership include elected representative, officers, chairpersons, captains, editors, managers, and leadership in the classroom.

#### Part 3: Character

Character is defined as the maintenance of ethical and moral standards that have been established by society. These include such characteristics as honesty, reliability, courtesy and respect for others. For example, no student may be inducted into the National Honor Society that has plagiarized.

Students must include <u>two recommendations</u> in the membership packet. <u>One must be a form completed by a teacher at Franklin High School and a written letter from someone outside of school.</u> The recommendations must attest to the student's character and integrity. Recommendation letters must be from adults who are not the student's parent, guardian, or other relative. Place the recommendation form or letter in a sealed envelope and put the envelope in the large envelope containing your membership forms.

#### The Final Step: Membership Procedure

All of the membership materials are to be placed in a large, sealed envelope with the student's name and homeroom teacher printed neatly in the upper right hand corner. Be sure to include the membership forms and recommendations in the large envelope. <u>Incomplete packets will not be considered</u>. The packet is to be turned into Mr. Sommer personally in room 111. Do NOT place the packet in a mailbox.

All membership application packets are due by XXXXX. <u>There are no time extensions for any reason.</u>
